



The Skaters Fund

Founded by coach Charles Fetter in 1998, the Skaters Fund assists all coaches and performing skaters who need financial assistance due to natural disaster, injury, sickness, disability, or age. Since its inception, the Skaters Fund has awarded over \$130,000 in assistance to over 50 recipients. Charles Fetter passed away in August of 2014 following a 12-year battle with cancer. Among his final wishes was that the Skaters Fund become a part of the PS Foundation and continue to provide assistance to coaches and performing skaters in need. His wishes became a reality when the fund was formally turned over to the PS Foundation at a ceremony at the 2015 Conference and Trade Show by his widow, Sandy Fetter.

Emergency Assistance

Emergency funding is available for up to \$2,000 for all coaches and performing skaters who need financial assistance due to natural disaster, injury, sickness, disability, or age.

Financial Assistance

Requests for financial assistance in excess of \$2,000 can be made for all coaches and performing skaters who need financial assistance due to natural disaster, injury, sickness, disability, or age.
