

RATING REQUIREMENTS - GENERAL *(Effective July 1st, 2008)*

BASIC ACCREDITATION (BA) RATING EXAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be an associate, intern or full member of the PSA.
2. Must have attended a PSA approved education program within one year prior to writing the exam.

This is a written exam composed of multiple choice and true/false questions. Once you register for this exam you will receive a BA Study Guide to assist in the preparation for the exam.

SPORT SCIENCE & MEDICINE (SS) RATING EXAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a full member of the PSA.
2. Must have passed the PSA Basic Accreditation exam and attended a PSA approved education program within one year prior to writing the exam.

There are four Sport Science and Medicine exams (registered, certified, senior and master) that are written exams composed of multiple choice and true/false questions. They are a component along with the applicable oral rating exam required to receive a discipline rating certificate. The "Coach's Guide to Figure Skating Sport Science and Medicine" (study guide) is available for purchase through PSA.

ORAL EXAM REQUIREMENTS:

1. Must be a full member of the PSA.
2. Must have passed the PSA Basic Accreditation exam.
3. Must meet the requirements outlined for each discipline rating prior to taking the oral rating exam. Please refer to each discipline for more information.
4. Applications will include a one-page resume which must be submitted with each oral rating application.

The oral exams are one hour in length plus a 15 minute evaluation period. Guides to Sample Questions are available for purchase by discipline through PSA.
